#### KINDY 2019 ENROLMENT INTERVIEWS

**SOFTIS TISSUE FUNDRAING INITIATIVE**— The P&F thank you for supporting the Softis Tissue/Fiona Wood Foundation initiative. **Thomas' Story** SOFTIS Tissues is a fundraising concept that was created by Thomas' dad, Adam Frediani, one of our current Liwara families. When Thomas was very little, he and his dad were cooking and a very bad accident occurred. Thomas burned his chest and right arm so badly that he needed to go to Perth Children's Hospital Foundation (previously PMH), but he knew that he needed help if he wanted to make a real difference. So, SOFTIS Tissues were born. Each packet of 200 tissues costs \$2.50 & from this price, \$1 per pack is donated directly to PMH & Fiona Wood Foundation for the purpose of paediatric burns research and 70c per pack is retained by the school to be used for fundraising purposes. Each family have been given 10 pkt which we ask that you sell to your family, friends & neighbours and send the \$25 back to school at the start of Term 3. If you would like more tissues please contact the P&F.

*IT PD AT LIWARA* Liwara played the host for, 4 of our neighbouring school Leadership & IT Teams, St Anthony's Wanneroo, Whitfords Catholic, St Elizabeth's Hocking & St Andrew's Clarkson where we had Standout Education work with us for half a day to upskill the teams on some of the LeadingLights Initatives. The session was very well received and we will be continuing this collaboration for the remainder of the year with our classroom teachers.

## Teach kids to problem solve By Michael Grose

When parents solve all children's problems we not only increase their dependency on adults but we teach them to be afraid of making mistakes. That's fertile ground for anxiousness and perfectionism, which often go hand in hand. Kids get used to bringing their problems to parents to solve. Of course, if you keep solving them, they'll keep bringing



them. "Mum, my sister is annoying me?" "Dad, can you ask my teacher to pick me for the team?" "Hey, I can't find my socks!"

It's tempting if you are in a time-poor family to simply jump in and help kids out.

Alternatively, you can take a problem-solving approach, cuing them to resolve their own problems and take responsibility for their concerns. "What can you do to make her stop annoying you?" "What's the best approach to take with your teacher?" "Socks, smocks! Where might they be?"

Here are 5 questions you can ask kids to encourage them to resolve their own problems:

#### 1. "Can you solve this yourself?"

Get kids thinking they can do it.

#### 2. "What do you think needs to happen?"

Start kids thinking about solving problems.

#### 3. "What's the first step?"

Sometimes just getting kids started is enough to get them working out issues themselves.

#### 4. "How would you like me to help?"

Get kids considering the type of assistance they need.

#### 5. "What's the best way to do this?"

Get kids assessing and prioritising.

Problem-solving is one of the four major skills (optimism, social skills & independence being the others) that resilient kids share, yet it's the one that many of us aren't equipped to develop. Start by stepping back and asking good questions when kids bring you their problems to solve.

# sustainable Living

Our school has now joined 'Bright Smiles, Bright Futures' recycling program that accepts: Any brand of used toothpaste tubes, toothbrushes, plastic toothbrush packaging, interdental brushes, wisps, pumps, stand up toothpaste bottles and any kind of non-electric toothbrush or toothpaste tube and all affiliated non-recyclable packaging.

#### Best practices for recycling:

In order to recycle this waste stream properly, please make sure all excess product has been removed (i.e. leftover toothpaste). Additionally, if you choose to rinse your product, please note that it must be completely dry prior to shipping. You cannot ship dripping packages.

#### What happens to the waste:

Once collected, the oral waste and foil wraps are cleaned and melted into hard plastic that can be remoulded to make new recycled products.

A collection box will be placed in the undercover to the right of the canteen.
