

INTRASCHOOL AND INTERSCHOOL SELECTION POLICY

Swimming carnival

BEFORE the FACTION Swimming Carnival:

- The students will be placed into divisions based on their times from the previous year and their swimming level.
- The fastest 8 times will compete in A Division, next fastest 8 in B Division and any other children in C Division or modified events.
- There is NO LIMIT as to how many swimmers may represent a faction in one event.

DURING the FACTION Swimming Carnival:

- Students will receive a ribbon for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th.
- Champion Boy and Girl points are for the fastest four times in each swimming stroke except Butterfly. They are scored in the following way:

Place	Points Awarded
1 st	5
2 nd	3
3 rd	2
4 th	1

INTERSCHOOL SELECTION:

- Only children in Year 4 to 6 will be considered for the interschool swimming squad.
- Children with the four fastest times in each stroke will make up the Interschool training squad. Other swimmers may be asked to attend training sessions if they were unable to attend the Faction carnival.
- Children who are selected for the Interschool squad will be timed during training sessions and placed in interschool divisions based on their best time.

CROSS COUNTRY

BEFORE the Faction Cross Country:

• During students' designated sport time, students from Year 1-6 will participate in practice cross country events where they will run the course.

INTERSCHOOL SELECTION - DURING THE FACTION CROSS COUNTRY:

• Students that finish in the first six places will go to Interschool from years 2 – 6.

ABSENT DURING THE FACTION CROSS COUNTRY:

• If a student is absent from the Cross Country School Carnival, they will not be considered for the Interschool Squad.



ATHLETICS CARNIVAL

BEFORE the Athletics Carnival:

:

• Students will be placed into divisions based on their performance during sport lessons.

DURING THE ATHLETICS CARNIVAL:

• Students will receive a ribbon for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th.

2 nd	3
3 rd	2
4 th	1

INTERSCHOOL SELECTION

Students (boys and girls) with the four fastest times from all divisions will be selected for Interschool 100 and 200m. Students (boys and girls) with the two fastest times for 400m will be selected for Interschool. 400m events will be run during Physical Education lessons.

THROWS AND JUMPS FACTION:

• During Physical Education lessons students will participate and compete in the throwing and jumping events (Long jump, High jump (Yr. 5 and 6), Turbojav, Vortex and Shotput).

Throws and Jumps Events:

• Two boys and two girls from years 3 – 6 who jump and/or throw the furthest qualify for Interschool.
