We are seeking an enthusiastic and innovative person to join the Liwara Catholic Primary School community. The position is currently for 19 hours per week, worked over Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday, with the possibility of negotiating the hours and days with the successful candidate.

Liwara is a double stream, co-educational, K-6 Catholic school. The school enjoys strong community support, good facilities and a committed staff team. The canteen manager's role is an important point of contact for the school community therefore the highest standards of confidentiality and integrity are required.

The expectation, is that the successful candidate is able to provide freshly prepared healthy and appealing meals and snacks for the students and staff.

Our school canteen offers a variety of healthy foods and drinks for recess and lunch. Each item on our menu is classified in accordance with the Star Choice Food Registration Program implemented in WA using the 'Traffic Light' coding system, recommended by the Canteen Association of Western Australia and the Department of Health WA.

Selection Criteria:

Demonstrate the ability to lead, plan, organise and control the day to day operations of the canteen including, stock control, volunteer rosters and banking.

Demonstrate the ability to prepare healthy and appealing home cooked meals & deliver food in a timely and efficient manner.

Ability to work with the Star Choice Food Program using the Traffic Light coding system as recommended by the Canteen Association of WA and the Department of Health WA.

Have competent computer skills and experience in working with online ordering (Quickcliq or similar).

Knowledge of hygiene, food safe handling and to be aware of Occupational Safety and Health standards.

Experience in a canteen manager's role or in similar food service with TAFE qualifications in canteen operations or similar will be highly regarded.

Personal qualities including flexibility, tact, confidentiality, diplomacy, punctuality, reliability and a sense of humour will be beneficial.

Essential:

Applicants must have a current Working With Children clearance and National Police Clearance obtained from the Department of Education Screening Unit.

Applicants must be supportive of the objectives and ethos of Catholic education and abide by the Liwara Staff Code of Conduct.
