This year we have successfully implemented the BYOD approach for Year 4 students and have provided the necessary support and infrastructure for students to use their owned technology effectively.

Digital Technologies and Design and Technologies are mandatory under the Western Australian Curriculum. It is very important for Liwara's 2020 Year 4 students, to bring in a device which is explicitly authorised as part of their back to school supplies.

We invite all parents of Liwara's this year's Year Three students, to attend the parent information meeting which will be held on Tuesday September 24th at 5.00pm in the Year 4 classrooms.
