Our school is a thriving community with specialist teachers in Science, Music, Physical Education, Italian and Visual Arts. Liwara is recognised as a place of quality teaching and learning, where innovative and dedicated staff members work closely together to provide the best possible educational opportunities for students in safe and positive learning environments, where they can flourish. Our Gifted and Talented Program provides challenging and highly motivating learning opportunities for children with exceptional capacity or creative talent and our Enrichment Program work closely with students to support them in their individual learning needs.

Liwara is a double stream, Catholic, co-educational school catering for students in a 3 Year Old - Pre Kindy Program through to Year 6.

Since 1974, Liwara has provided a Catholic education for its students, offering varied programs, giving them opportunities to grow in their faith and to become confident, lifelong learners, conscious about the responsibilities they have for their world and for each other.

As part of our commitment to the mental health and wellbeing of our students we are a KidsMatter School and implement the following programs from Kindergarten through to Year Six: PATHS; Aussie Optimism; Rock & Water; Buddy Classes Initiative; Levels of Behaviour; availability of the Sensory Room and Safe4Kids which specialises in child protection education. KidsMatter Primary is a mental health and wellbeing initiative for Australian primary schools. It provides proven methods, resources and support to identify and implement whole school strategies to improve student mental health and wellbeing. As well as all these initiatives listed above we have the additional support of Mrs Jane Evans, our Social Worker who runs URSTRONG Friendology Schools Plus - a friendship program that inspires children to feel empowered, develop a strong sense of self and love themselves while learning to manage the most important thing to them....their friendships; FunFriends - an early intervention and prevention of anxiety and depression as well as focussing on social skills; Season for Growth - a loss and grief support group offered for various year levels depending on need; EdConnect - a mentoring and in-class support program provided through EdConnect Australia where mentors spend an hour a week during school time.

The main focus of the mentoring is to match students with a mentor to provide support, be a positive role model and to improve students' self esteem and confidence, whilst engaging with positive adult role models. In building the learning power of our students we encourage our children to approach learning challenges with a core set of habits, skills and attitudes in a school environment that promotes Christian witness through words and actions. The school enjoys a strong, collaborative relationship with the All Saints Parish working together to offer our students opportunities to engage in rich and meaningful experiences that will enrich their faith journeys. Members of the School Board and Parents and Friends Association work closely with the school to build and strengthen a vibrant community spirit.
