Outside School Hours Care - is available to students from Kindy to Year 6.

OUR AIMS

We aim to provide a physically safe and emotionally secure environment where children can explore, socialise and expand their interests through a variety of artistic, physical and social activities and interact with peers. My Time, Our Place Framework

The My Time, Our Place is the framework for school aged children in Outside School Hours Care in Australia. It has a specific emphasis on play-based learning and recognises the importance of communication, language, social and emotional development.

The framework ensures children have opportunities to engage in leisure and play-based experiences which are responsive to their needs, interests and choices. My Time, Our Place promotes the idea that children attending the service fully contribute to their ongoing development. The framework aims to support and provide guidance to educators working with school age children in Outside School Hours Care.
