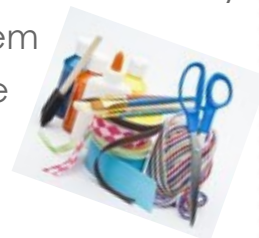
It would be fantastic if each family could donate a plant to this beautiful stall! Get your cuttings struck as soon as possible!!
