



Smart Freeway Mitchell Southbound: Hester Avenue to Warwick Road

Works to commence at Liwara Primary School carpark

As part of the Smart Freeway Mitchell Southbound project, a new Principal Shared Path (PSP) will be constructed between Ocean Reef Road and Warwick Train Station, with existing sections to be upgraded.

This will significantly benefit your local community, with improved path access becoming easier, safer and more attractive. The freeway will also be widened adjacent to Liwara Primary School.

To enable the PSP works, Main Roads has negotiated the purchase of a portion of the school's early learning area/staff carpark.

The carpark will be re-developed as part of this arrangement, which will include a new drainage system to minimise future flooding events.

The majority of the carpark works will be completed during the summer holidays, commencing this Saturday 10 December.

The works will include:

- installation of temporary fencing
- vegetation clearing and topsoil removal
- drainage (trenching, construction of new drainage structures)
- kerbing
- construction of a new footpath, retaining wall and carpark (pavement preparation, priming and sealing with bitumen)
- installation of new signage
- linemarking and landscaping.

Some of the landscaping may need to be postponed until the cooler months next year, however irrigation options are being reviewed.
