



LIWARA CATHOLIC OUTSIDE SCHOOL HOURS CARE NON-ENROLLED CHILDREN ON THE PREMISES POLICY

POLICY STATEMENT

All children attending our service must be enrolled appropriately. A child who is not enrolled at Liwara Catholic Outside School Hours Care may not be present at our service unless the child is visiting the service and in the company of an adult who is supervising them.

While on the premises a non-enrolled child is expected to abide by the rules of the service. An adult accompanying the child must also abide by the policies and procedures of the service in regard to the management of that child.

Staff members who wish their child to be cared for at the service must have the permission of the Centre manager or School Principal and that child must be enrolled in the service. Non-enrolled children to the service may not be cared for unless there are extenuating circumstances.

In exceptional circumstances care may be provided for a non-enrolled child until alternative arrangements can be made for their care. In the case of a non-enrolled child being present the Nominated Supervisor shall take responsibility for the child until such time a parent can collect the child or arrangements have been made with the appropriate persons.
