When moving from front gate to vehicle children will follow educator and listen to instructions. Children must remain seated and in their own seat while on the bus and seatbelts will be worn while the bus is in transit. Children are not permitted to open door or get out of the vehicle unless given permission to do so. In case of an emergency the bus will pull over to a safe location and contact the centre Director/ Coordinator to assist. In case of a breakdown the staff member will call the RAC for assistance or organise a relief staff member or school principal - Andrea Millar - to collect children. A first aid box will also be stored in the vehicle.	 SPF 30+ broad spectrum water resistant sunscreen will be provided for children and applied 20 minutes before going outside. Outdoor play will not occur in extreme heat or at the hottest time of the day. Staff will act as role models, by wearing hats and following sun smart procedures. Sunscreen protection will be provided at all times throughout all seasons. It is recommended that children and educators wear loose fitting clothing that protects as much of the skin as possible for outdoor activities. Shirts that cover the shoulders and have collars and sleeves in addition to longer style skirts and shorts are most suitable.
	 Children wearing tank tops, singlets or dresses with strappy shoulders will be required to play in an area protected from the sun. On excursions children MUST wear their school hats as this assists ease of identification.
