At Liwara Catholic Primary we want to feel safe, included, accepted, and cared for...

- 1. In order to feel **safe** we will not put ourselves in danger, we will stay on the school grounds and observe our surroundings. When someone isn't feeling this way, or there is conflict, we will walk away from the situation and talk to a trusted adult.
- 2. In order to feel **included** we will ask to join in and be observant of the people that are not being included. When someone isn't feeling this way, or there is conflict, we will speak up and ask others to play.
- 3. In order to feel **accepted** we will be kind to others and treat others the way we want to be treated. When someone isn't feeling this way, or there is conflict, we will play with others that will accept you, be yourself and find a teacher or trusted adult.
- 4. In order to feel cared for we will talk to someone if you are upset and keep playing with the group that makes you feel cared for. When someone isn't feeling this way, or there is conflict, we will talk to a trusted adult and get some advice.
